#### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Mangalore Refinery and Petrochemicals Limited (MRPL) is a "Schedule –A" CPSE and a subsidiary of Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC). The Refinery has a versatile design with high flexibility to process Crude with 24 to 46 API gravity and has high degree of Automation. The Refinery including the Aromatic Complex has a Nelson Complexity number of 10.63. The present capacity of the Refinery is 15 MMTPA. Products of MRPL are mainly sold in the domestic market to the PSU Oil Marketing Companies (OMC's) and balance products are exported. MRPL is also increasing its Retail presence currently.

- 1.2 MRPL is intending to procure 600 TPD(Ton per day) of CORSIA certified pre-treated oils from suppliers for producing sustainable aviation fuel (SAF) in its production facilities.

#### 2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 As part of the United Nations plan to offset aviation emission, Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation (CORSIA) is being implemented to address any annual increase in CO2 from international civil aviation above the 2020 levels. At present India is not a signatory to the voluntary compliance phase of the scheme. However, India will be participating in the second phase of CORSIA from 2027 onwards during which Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) is required to be blended with crude oil-based jet fuel to reduce net CO2 emissions.
- 2.2 In this context, MRPL intends to procure CORSIA certified treated oil from suppliers on a Long-term basis up to 15 years to process in its HEFA process-based Bio-ATF plant and Hydrotreating units stagewise.
- 2.3 This Expression of Interest (EOI) invites suppliers to submit proposals for the supply up to 600 TPD of CORSIA certified pre-treated oils meeting the technical and commercial requirements outlined below, ensuring alignment with CORSIA (Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation) and ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organization) guidelines.
- 2.4 The supplier may indicate the quantity that can be supplied to MRPL.
- 2.5 The supplier should supply the Pretreated oil to MRPL Refinery premises at Mangalore.
- 2.6 The pretreated oils must meet technical and commercial criteria outlined below.

#### 3.0 <u>TECHNICAL CRITERIA</u>

- 3.1 Oil must be listed under material eligible for the CORSIA Sustainability Certification Scheme (e.g., ISCC, RSB, ClassNK SCS). The details of CORSIA eligible feeds can be obtained from <a href="https://www.icao.int/environmental-protection/Pages/SAF">https://www.icao.int/environmental-protection/Pages/SAF</a> Feedstocks.aspx.
- 3.2 Oils must be derived from sustainable sources. The tentative list of oil's is provided below. However, it is not exhaustive:
  - 3.2.1 Used Cooking Oil (UCO)

- 3.2.2 Palm Fatty Acid Distillate (PFAD)
- 3.2.3 Palm Oil Mill Effluent (POME)
- 3.2.4 Jatropha (Jatropha curcas)
- 3.2.5 Pongamia (Pongamia pinnata or Pongamia glabra) Oil
- 3.2.6 Neem (Azadirachta indica) Oil
- 3.2.7 Rapeseed Oil
- 3.2.8 Other Tree Borne non-edible oil
- 3.2.9 Any other CORSIA certified oil
- 3.3 Supplier shall submit the CORSIA certification of the proposed oil supply to MRPL along with this EOI. If the same is not available, the supplier shall obtain the certification before the actual supply to MRPL. The details of the same shall be submitted along with this EOI.
- 3.4 Oil supplied to MRPL shall be pretreated to remove metals and other impurities. Detailed Specification shall be shared during the tendering process. The specifications of the Oil proposed by the Supplier should be furnished along with the EOI.

#### 4.0 COMMERCIAL CRITERIA

- 4.1 Supplier shall be able to meet the requirement of oil quantity specified in the EOI. The quantities required will be indicated on a quarterly basis during the tender process.
- 4.2 Supplier shall indicate the volume of Oil available for supply along with scalability options and delivery schedule.
- 4.3 Supplier shall provide detailed pricing structure and landed cost supply at MRPL, Mangalore, including cost breakdown.
- 4.4 Supplier shall specify proposed terms, source of Oil including contract duration for both spot and long term, payment schedules, terms of payment and flexibility in supply volumes.
- 4.5 Supplier shall guarantee the consistent availability of Oil to meet demand as per agreed terms.

#### **5.0 DOCUMENTATION**

- 5.1 Supplier shall provide documentary evidence supporting the technical and commercial criteria.
- 5.2 Technical specifications of the oil, including pre-treatment process details.
- 5.3 Certifications and sustainability documentation.

- 5.4 Commercial proposal outlining pricing, delivery, and contract terms.
- 5.5 References from existing customers (if available).
- 5.6 Supplier shall provide supporting documents for companies involved in the Production / supply of non-edible biological oils.
- 5.7 Financial turnover details viz. Balance Sheets, Profit / Loss Account, etc. for the past four financial years
- 5.8 Other relevant documents, in support of the credentials.
